




Stemming the flow of mass firings

Like many of you, we are disheartened by ongoing reports that numerous staff from the U.S. Forest Service and other key federal agencies across the region are being fired in the name of government efficiency. Many of these individuals are our neighbors. So far, over 100 employees from public land management agencies in the region have lost their jobs, and yesterday the Trump administration issued another executive order requiring federal agencies to further reduce their staff.

Please take a few moments to send your Senators and Representatives a note about this. If you reside in Oregon, you can use this pre-crafted letter: <u>Tell Congress to stop the mass firings of federal employees.</u>
